This winter has seen an increased number of break-ins by some bold criminals. If you notice anything at all out of the ordinary in the neighborhood, please call 911 to report it – door-to-door transients asking for rides, for work, for handouts, wanting to paint house numbers, or selling meat, etc. Many of these people are casing the neighborhood to see if anyone is home. If you notice someone lurking in your back yard, or trying to pick up packages or mail, please report these incidents to the police. If you are a member of HNSA, call them as well, and they can investigate. Membership in HNSA is far from 100% of neighborhood residents. The security patrol has let many suspicious characters know that they are being watched. Some of them have been arrested for having outstanding warrants. The patrol is doing a great job of protecting us, and this service is being paid for by a relatively small number of members. Please join with us to keep us safe. 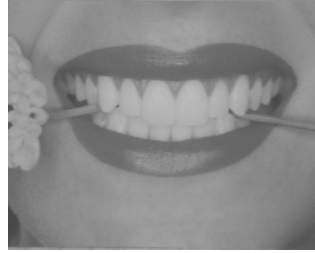
