

What is HNSA?

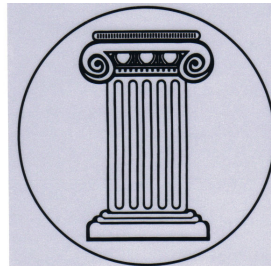

Neighborhood Security

Oklahoma City Police Department officers are working for us. The uniformed officers patrol our neighborhoods outside of their official police department schedules each week.

Patrol officers have the ability to act with the full authority of the law. They have their police radios on at all time and they are carrying their service weapons. They patrol in an HNSA owned and insured car that looks very similar to a police car. These individuals are highly trained professionals and can make arrests and otherwise enforce the law.

Our team has been educated about our communities. They understand our “hot spots”. Patrol officers have crime statistics on our area. You can expect to see the HNSA car patrolling the neighborhoods and the perimeter streets. The patrol officers are aware security concerns to relating Broadway Avenue and on N.W. 23rd Street which are perimeter streets.

A dedicated mobile phone allows HNSA members to reach a patrol officer directly during patrol hours.

Patrol hours are communicated in routine mailings to members.

Emergency Protocols

Call 911 if you have any concerns or if someone or something looks odd or unfamiliar. This is the only way that the city can effectively track crime or other activity. Don't wait until there is an emergency. This is a common misconception. Your call to 911 allows the city to track suspicious activity and other issues. Don't be afraid to call.

Call HNSA. The second call that you make will be to the HNSA mobile phone. As a member, you will be provided with the phone number and gift items to help you remember the number.
